We are seeking to employ a Postdoctoral Researcher at the Centre for Polar Studies at the University of Silesia.

The ideal applicant will be a persons with an impeccable ethical demeanour, complying with the conditions imposed by article 109 paragraph 1 of the Act of 27 July 2005 on the Law on Higher Education (the Journal of Law No. 164, item. 1365, as amended).

Application is open to the most outstanding young scientists who have a doctoral degree in Earth Sciences or other related sciences, obtained abroad, not earlier than in 2013, on the basis of the dissertation or scientific achievements published in English language.

Salary: an equivalent of €2000 to €2500 gross per month (Please note, that the cost of living in Poland is much more lower than in Western Europe).

The candidate must have:

- suitable scientific attainments in the field of glaciology and numerical modelling of glaciers,
- documented active participation in international conferences and in research projects,
- Excellent English verbal and written communication skills confirmed by relevant certificates,
- basic experience in field studies of glaciers would be an advantage.

The candidate will be participate in teaching (Earth Sciences) in English of at least 110 hours per academic year, and carry out scientific research and organizational work. The total working time will be an average of 40 hours per week. Information about salary on request.

Job description:

- modelling the dynamics of the frontal zone of tidewater glaciers and the interactions of the glacier with the ocean (MATLAB, Fortran, C++);
- the candidate will be required to prepare a grant application in international cooperation and to publish at least two publications (in JCR journals) within the duration of the contract.

Information:

The results of the competition should be announced no later than within 2 months from the date of its opening. The assessment of the qualifications and skills of the candidate and their suitability for the job of postdoctoral research (Post doc) will be carried out by an international competition committee. The results of the competition will be decided by the Department of Earth Sciences. The candidate will be employed by the Rector, at the request of the Dean and Head of the Centre for Polar Studies, approved by the Council of the Faculty of Earth Sciences. The employment will have the character of a contract for a specified period of time. The expected period of employment: from 1.10.2016 to 31.12.2018.
