

## **AWAKE-2 Meeting**

### **03-04 December 2015, Sopot, Poland**

The third meeting of Polish-Norwegian **AWAKE-2** project was held on 3-4 December 2015 at Institute of Oceanology PAS in Sopot. The aim of the **AWAKE-2** (*Arctic Climate System Study of Ocean, Sea Ice and Atmosphere interactions*) is to understand the interactions between the key components of the climate system in the Svalbard area. In total, the meeting was attended by 23 participants from Poland and Norway, representing scientific fields of Cryosphere, Atmosphere and Ocean and we also had pleasure to host researchers from Spain.

The meeting begun with a speech given by Assoc. Prof. Ksenia Pazdro, after which the main plenary session started.

The first day of the meeting was devoted to presentations of results obtained by particular work packages ([link](#)). Mgr Agnieszka Promińska was responsible for **Task 3.1. Fjord hydrography from historical and new data**, which was a part of **WP3. Fjord Oceanography**. The presentation included results of analysis of hydrographic data collected in Hornsund fjord between 2001 – 2014, as well as summary of a fieldwork performed in 2015.

The second day started with brief summary of the previous day, after which a discussion was open. Leaders and collaborators of work packages presented their future work, which was especially focused on the plans of publications as a synthesis of the results and a product of jointed work in different scientific areas.
